Visit Brief

- During a comprehensive discussion, Mr. N.T. Jadav, our Project Manager at AEECPL, reiterated our
 unwavering commitment to ONGC in the provision of Installation Safety Officers. The presentation
 encompassed an overview of AEECPL's organizational structure, highlighting the technical and
 administrative support available to Safety Officers. Additionally, we introduced the Project Manager
 from our corporate office and Project Coordinators stationed in ONGC's Delhi and Mumbai offices.
- Furthermore, we underscored that all AEECPL Safety Officers deployed can readily access the AEECPL Team for support and communication. ONGC expressed its intent to promptly assemble a dedicated team for deploying Safety Officers across various locations.
- AEECPL also shared the reporting formats it has developed, with a focus on their implementation.
 Notably, ONGC preferred that one of the AEECPL Safety Officers submits daily reports in digital format on behalf of the entire deployment, as ONGC would not be furnishing a dedicated reporting system for this purpose.
- Moreover, the protocol dictates that each individual AEECPL Safety Officer assumes responsibility for daily reporting to their respective senior ONGC office, with one designated AEECPL Safety Officer assigned to report to the HSE Department. To ensure transparency, a duplicate of the same report will be forwarded to the AEECPL Coordination Team.
