Visit Brief

- In a comprehensive discussion, our Project Manager, Mr. N.T. Jadav, from AEECPL reaffirmed the organization's steadfast commitment to ONGC in providing Installation Safety Officers. The presentation included an overview of AEECPL's organizational structure, highlighting the technical and administrative support available to Safety Officers. Details about the Project Manager from the corporate office and Project Coordinators based in Delhi and Mumbai ONGC offices were also provided.
- Additionally, it was emphasized that all safety officers deputed by AEECPL can readily access the AEECPL Team for support and communication. ONGC expressed its intention to swiftly assemble a dedicated team for the deputation of Safety Officers at various locations.
- AEECPL shared the reporting formats it has prepared, with discussions centred around their implementation. Notably, ONGC preferred one of the AEECPL Safety Officers to submit daily reports in soft copy on behalf of the entire deputation, as ONGC would not be providing a dedicated reporting system for this purpose.
- Furthermore, the protocol stipulates that each individual AEECPL Safety Officer is responsible for daily reporting to their respective senior ONGC office, with one AEECPL Safety Officer designated to report to the HSE Department. To ensure transparency, a copy of the same report will be forwarded to the AEECPL Coordination Team.
