- Detailed discussions were held regarding the classification and management of incidents, including near-miss events, accidents, and Dangerous Occurrences (D.O.).
- Emphasis was placed on effective observation reporting methodologies to improve reporting accuracy and response times.

#### 3. Work-Related Safety Induction:

- Both basic and advanced safety induction training was delivered, covering essential worksite safety protocols and best practices to ensure safe working conditions across various operations.

#### 4. Identification and Discussion of Safety Gaps:

- The team conducted a thorough review of the current safety processes, highlighting areas of concern and safety gaps.
- Constructive guidance and suggestions were provided to address these gaps effectively, with recommendations to improve safety compliance and operational performance.

#### 5. One-on-One Performance Assessment Discussions:

- Individual sessions were held with each safety officer to assess their performance, identify challenges, and offer tailored technical support.
- Additionally, discussions were held regarding HR-related support, ensuring the safety officers have the necessary resources and guidance to improve their professional development.

The visit successfully provided the necessary training, support, and guidance to enhance the capabilities of the safety officers, helping them meet the safety requirements effectively & improve overall safety performance.
