1. REMOVE DAVIT HARBOUR SAFETY PIN.
2. LOWER EMBARKATION LADDER.
3. RELEASE CENTER GRIPE.
4. LIFT BRAKE BAR & LOWER THE BOAT UPTO EMBARKATION DECK.
5. CONNECT BOWSING TACKLE.
6. ENSURE DRAIN PLUG IN PLACE.
7. TIGHTEN BOWSING TACKLES & SLIP TRICING PENDANTS.
8. BOARD LIFEBOAT, LOWER BOAT BY PULLING SELF LOWERING WIRE.
9. START ENGINES WHEN BOAT IN WATER
10. RELEASE FALLS STEER BOAT AWAY FROM drill SHIP.
